Recycling

A good recycler brings clean and dry recyclables to the recycle center. Please rinse the contents out of containers and bottles, especially food, milk, beer or soda pop. We will not accept items that have rotting food in them.

Acceptable items include:

- aluminum cans
- tin or steel cans
- cell phones, tablets, laptop computers
- cartridges for laser printers, faxes and copiers
- cartridges for inkjet printers
- glass bottles and jars
- plastic bottles & containers (1,2,3,4,5,7) - excluding #6: Polystyrene
- paper including:
 - dairy and juice cartons/containers
 - paperboard
 - magazines
 - cardboard
 - newspapers
 - junk mail

Large Appliances and Machinery

Large appliances and machinery that are primarily composed of metal are accepted for recycling (for instance: any bulk metal, refrigerator, freezer, clothes washer/dryer, and dishwashers). Call the recycle center if you would like to request a pick up from your home for a minimum donation of \$25 based on your distance from the recycle center. Scheduling of the pickup will be based on volunteer availability.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS MATERIAL

The Stella Roberts Recycling Center collects a donation from non-residents of \$1 per pound for Household Hazardous Waste.

Residents outside Brazoria County will be able to drop off Household Hazardous Waste with a donation to KPBB of \$1 per pound

Residents of Pearland wishing to bring Household Hazardous Waste will be required to provide a current copy of their water bill. Residents of Brazoria County must provide a picture ID with their address on it.

Household Hazardous ITEMS ACCEPTED:

Flammables such as oil based paint and paint-related products

Oxidizers such as pool chemicals

Corrosives such as acids and certain cleansers

Batteries (including Alkaline)

Motor oil, filters and cooking oil

Antifreeze

Latex paint

TIPS FOR PAINT DISPOSAL

Paint must be in original container. (i.e. no plastic food containers, milk jugs, mason jars etc.)

Empty plastic paint cans will NOT be accepted, let them dry out and put them in your trash.

Pour 1/2 full cans of paint together to make cans full; no longer accepting numerous 1/2 full cans of paint

Paint with dried paint layers are no longer accepted, let the can completely dry and put it in your trash.

TRANSPORTING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Make sure the containers are not leaking and DO NOT combine your hazardous materials into a plastic bag. This will almost always cause a leak or spill. Leaking or spilled materials will not be accepted at the Recycling Center.

When recycling used motor oil please place the oil in a reusable container that you can take home with you to reuse.
