



# Plastic Bottle Campus Recycling



## Items provided by KPB:

- Corrugated Plastic Recycle Bins - Bottles & Cans 38" (44 gal.)
- 44 gal Plastic Bags (If your campus prefers schools bags, the must be white/clear, translucent bags)



## Requirements:

- Must have Principal Approval to implement program.
- Must have at least two teachers on board with recycling beverage containers- It's best to have support for recycling and recycling correctly. Making sure staff is aware that KPB has partnered with your school on these recycling efforts.
- Must have the custodians on board with recycling- Having custodians on board will help prevent contamination.
- The Stella Roberts Recycling Center now requires recyclables to be in Translucent plastic bags.



## Things to Keep In Mind:

- A known issue that we run into with recycling in the cafeteria is contamination. Kids throw in half full bottles of soda/juice and this can not be recycled.
- Bins can be located in main halls or the teachers lounge.
- Recycling Pickups are determined by individual campuses.
- Recycling Pickup Locations are determined by individual campuses.
- Schools will be contacted regarding contamination and tips to improve.
- Bins are loaned, if program is canceled, bins must be returned.
